

Domain Registration

Background

Most countries have their own Top Level Domain (TLD). The .uk TLD was first used during the 1980s, and at that time a voluntary group called the Naming Committee managed the registration of .uk domain names.

By the early 1990s, commercial companies started to sell domain names to customers. As demand for domain name registrations grew, it became clear that a voluntary group could no longer cope with the volume of registrations being requested. A new organisation was needed to manage the .uk TLD and as a result Nominet UK was formed.

Nominet was established in 1996 as a private, not-for-profit company, limited by guarantee.

Intunet is an authorised and approved Registrar of .uk domain names.

By registering a .uk domain name, via Intunet you enter into a contract of registration with Nominet UK on these [terms and conditions](#). Please read the Terms and Conditions before registering a .uk domain name.

Our Charges

Our charge for registering a .uk domain name for a period of 2 years is £20.00 plus VAT.

Our charge for renewing a .uk domain name is £20.00 plus VAT.

Any other charges made by Nominet are passed on directly.

Our Service

Domains are registered within 1 working day or as soon as practicably possible. You are free to move your domain whenever you like although there may be charge made by Nominet. We guarantee all domain transfers from Intunet will be carried out within 2 working days of a written request (or as soon as practicably possible).
